CN declares second-quarter 2016 dividend

MONTREAL, April 25, 2016 — CN (TSX: CNR) (NYSE: CNI) announced today that its Board of Directors has approved a second-quarter 2016 dividend on the Company's common shares outstanding. A quarterly dividend of thirty-seven-and-one-half cents (C\$0.375) per common share will be paid on June 30, 2016, to shareholders of record at the close of business on June 9, 2016.

CN is a true backbone of the economy, transporting more than C\$250 billion worth of goods annually for a wide range of business sectors, ranging from resource products to manufactured products to consumer goods, across a rail network of approximately 20,000 route-miles spanning Canada and mid-America.
